### 2023-2024 OPTIONS

#### GSRP (Great Start Readiness Program) Grant

- **FREE** Full-day program 8:30 - 3:30, Monday - Thursday
- Families must meet the eligibility criteria established by the Michigan Department of Education and be able to document eligibility
- Children must be 4-years-old by Sept. 1 of the program year

#### CCAMPIS (Child Care Access Means Parents In School) Grant

- **FREE** Full-day program 8:30 - 3:30, Monday - Thursday
- For parents who are students at Wayne State University and Pell Grant eligible
- Parents must be registered for a minimum of 6 credit hours and maintain a GPA of 2.0
- Before school care from 8:00-8:30 is available for a fee

#### General Tuition Option

- Full-day program 8:30 - 3:30, Monday - Friday
- Before school care from 8:00-8:30 is available for an additional fee
