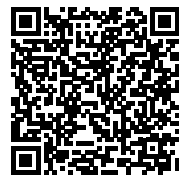

2023- 2024 GRANT PROGRAMS

CCAMPIS (Child Care Means Parents In School) Grant

- Full-day program 8:30 - 3:30, Monday - Thursday
- For parents who are students at Wayne State University and Pell Grant-eligible.
- Parents must be registered for a minimum of 6 credit hours and maintain a GPA of 2.0.
- Before school care from (8:00-8:30) is available for a fee.

GSRP (Great Start Readiness Program) Grant

- Full-day program 8:30 - 3:30 Monday - Thursday
- Families must meet the eligibility criteria established by the Michigan Department Education.
- Children must be four-years-old by Sept. 1 of the program year
- Parents/guardians must be able to document eligibility factors in accordance with MOE guidelines. Before school care from (8:00-8:30) is available for a fee.
