- Interview parents and teachers

- Transcribe clinical interviews
- Collect biological data
- Learn how to responsibly conduct research
- Enter data and provide childcare

Requirements:

To qualify for this opportunity the following requirements must be met:

- Two semester commitment at least 10 hours per week
- 3.2 minimum GPA
- Have some flexibility in your schedule for evenings and weekends
- Enjoy interacting with children and families
- A desire to work as a group and learn about parenting and attachment
