

Make Your Own Bubbles and Bubble Wands

Bubble Solution

1 cup water
2 tablespoons light karo
syrup or 2 tablespoons
glycerin
4 tablespoons dishwashing
liquid

Mix together and have fun!

Homemade Colored Bubbles

1 cup granulated soap or soap
powder
1 quart warm water
Liquid food coloring
Plastic straws
Small juice cans

Dissolve soap in warm water. Stir
in food coloring until desired color
is attained. Give each child a can
about 1/3 full of mix and a plastic
straw to blow the bubbles

Fancy Homemade Bubbles

1 cup water
2 tablespoons liquid detergent
1 tablespoon glycerin
1 teaspoon sugar

Mix all ingredients together
until sugar dissolves. Enjoy!

Wire hangers can be
manipulated (by a safety-
focused adult, of course)
into a variety of shapes and
sizes. Just use pliers to
straighten the wire first.
Then bend a large loop at
one end leaving room for a
handle. Close the loop off
by wrapping a bit of the end
around the handle.

You can also make them
with pipe cleaners!
